How to order using the RaiseRight App

- 1. Download the phone app called RaiseRight. Set up an account and use our ASLC enrollment code--21BE9CD476L8
 - a. Entering our enrollment code above ensures all proceeds go directly to All Saints.
 - b. This is really handy to have on your phone. For instance, if you go shopping at Pick n' Save, you can order an electronic gift card, and it places it in your "electronic wallet" in just a few seconds. Then it's available at the checkout for you to use immediately!
- 2. You can also set up an account at Raiseright.com on your computer at home. Register a family account and use our ASLC enrollment code listed above.
 - a. This is handy for ordering a gift card you would like to send electronically to a family member or friend as a gift.
 - b. You can also order a physical gift card, which will be sent to All Saints for you, or an electronic gift card that will go in your electronic "wallet."
 - c. You can order on the spot and do not have to plan a week ahead. For example, if your hot water heater goes out, you can use the App to buy a Home Depot ecard in any amount (\$5 increment), get the ecard on your phone, and then head to Home Depot. Also, for most merchant cards ordered through RaiseRight, cards can be ordered in almost any amount. You can buy a Home Depot card for \$1,450, so you don't have to go through 15 \$100 cards. Your bank transfer costs \$0.29 for each transaction, no matter what amount of gift card you order!
- 3. Set up a payment for online orders. You can attach it your checking account and it will cost \$0.29 for each transaction, no matter the amount of the gift card. You can also use a credit card, but there is a 3% transaction fee for using that.
- 4. Once you have an online account or the App, there additional bonuses that are only available on the website. You will get notifications of the online specials.
 - a. Recently there were cards for sale that offered a 17% rebate! WOW!
 - b. There are over 700 different companies which offer cards on the App or website.
