Fans for Hephatha Families

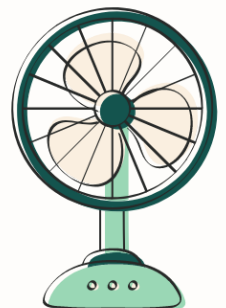
Do you have a fan in your basement or a closet that you're not using? Have you seen ads for fans on sale? Do you have a portable air conditioner that you don't need?

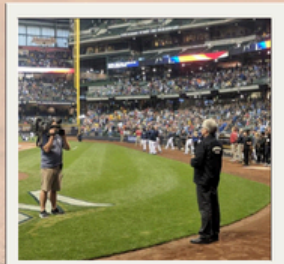
