

We are sure many families have started their back-to-school shopping. Maybe some of you are starting to think about holiday shopping. Be sure to get your orders in while you are making your lists! There is a list of all current gift cards available on the bulletin board by the Scrip table. Check through the list to see if there are some you would like us to order for you:

NEW—there is a new feature on the RaiseRight app called Local Dining.

If you attach a credit card or debit card to your app, you can earn additional money for church. Every time you dine and pay with that linked card, you'll automatically earn 5% for ASLC. Currently there are 186 listings in our area, and more are added every day. There is a FAQ section under Link, Dine, Earn for more information. Some local restaurants participating are Ella's Public House and Rise and Shine Café in Wales along with Pacific Bistro and Badger Burger Company.

Did you have an amazing trip this summer? Are you ready to order your pictures or make your photobook-- think Shutterfly or Walgreens! Are you considering using Wayfair or Overstock.com for some updates—we sell those! Have you gone to the Marcus Theatre lately? We can get those too. They can be used for tickets as well as your popcorn and beverage! Fall projects—Home Depot, Lowe's, ACE, Menards, Fleet Farm—we carry them!

You can also order any gift cards online at RaiseRight. Please register a family account and use our ASLC enrollment code--21BE9CD476L8. You will also need this code to set up an account on the RaiseRight app. There are some cards that are only available as e-cards and you would need to get the app to order and use those—like Airbnb or some airlines. We have enjoyed wonderful support from our congregation and ask that you continue to buy Scrip cards in the future. THE SUCCESS OF THE SONGORO SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



The scholarship program established with Songoro Parish, our partner congregation in Tanzania, is recognized by the partnership committee of the Greater Milwaukee Synod as a success. A number of Milwaukee area congregations that have partner congregations in the Meru Diocese are considering using the All Saints model for their scholarship programs.

This model is made up of a two part program. Members of all Saints support the portion of the program for secondary school students with their contributions during an appeal that raises funds each year. The Scholarship Program for Higher Education is supported by individual patrons that are linked with prospective students that have been recommended by the Scholarship Committee in Songoro Tanzania. These patrons commit to supporting their student throughout their college career.

Twenty-five Songoro students have already received, or are currently working on, their degrees because of our scholarship program. You can change a life by becoming a patron.
