## Financial Update – April 2026

\*Report Accurate as of the end of April 2026, rounded to nearest dollar

April Expenses: \$23,611

April Income: \$26,465(Yes, another net positive!!! Yay!)

Actual Expenses through April 2026: \$106,627

Planned Expenses through April 2026: \$99,982

Cumulative Income through April 2026: \$95,796

Income needed **weekly** to meet planned expenses \$5768

*(annual plan divided by 52)*

We had another good financial month in April, with another net positive month. Thank you to all of the extra mile projects (the craft fair especially) which helped propel us ahead! We are still “in the red” for the year but coming ever closer to being “in the black,” yet we also know we’ve got the likely leaner summer months soon ahead.

Council officers: Jeff Voelkel, Lance Ekum & Jon Schmidt, met with Pastor Jennifer met recently to discuss our finances at greater depth.

With mindfulness about our spending, and attempting to reduce spending in a few categories, we are reasonably optimistic about our financial picture (with the caveat of knowing our giving will likely slump a bit over the summer.)
