Why We Walk: One June 20th, 2026, we will walk in solidarity with people who are displaced, detained, and deported. We walk to remember that the journey to safety is often made on foot. We walk for those forced to leave home, those held behind bars, and those sent away from the lives they worked so hard to build.

We walk to educate ourselves and our communities.

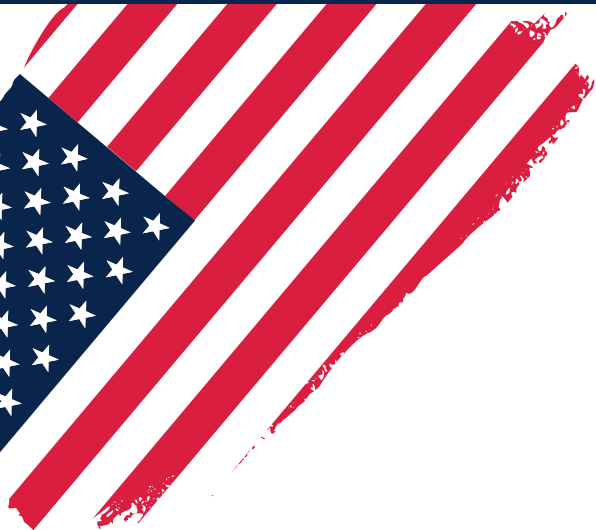
We walk to raise awareness.

We invite you to walk either one mile or three miles on June 20th, 2026, as an assembled group at Ascension Lutheran Church. We will gather at 8:30am. 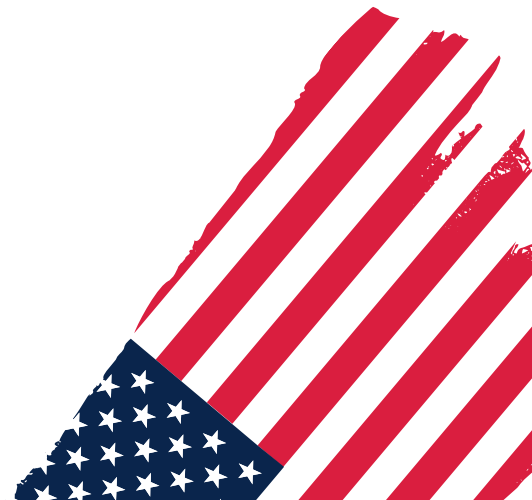

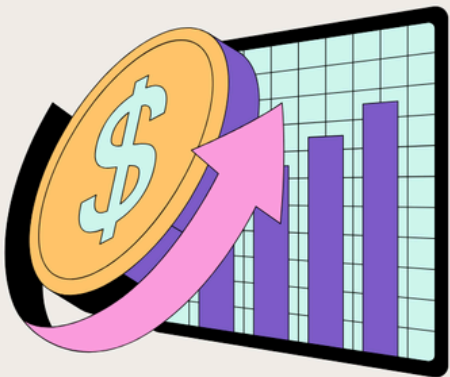
All Saints Youth

MOUNT MERU COFFEE

Thanks to the Tanzania Coffee research Institute, the Mount Meru farmers are now adding more coffee plants as a cash crop. The income from this cash crop is allowing for more children in school and more health care being accessed. Before the Mount Meru Coffee Project was established many farmers were uprooting their plants because the prices were low and it was not then worthwhile to grow coffee. This premium coffee is served during coffee hour and package coffee is available at our All Saints narthex display.



Summer Scrip News. Please think about your upcoming summer weddings, graduations, birthdays, retirements, etc. How about a summer party where you are bringing a hostess gift? Maybe think about getting a gift card you know they will use!

As you start to plan your vacations, please consider getting a gift card for your trips. We have gift cards available for most airlines, hotels, cruise lines, restaurants and even Airbnb along with Uber! Gas cards—we have them too, even those not local to Wisconsin. When you return, think Shutterfly or Walgreens when you order your pictures or make your photobooks. And the VISA cards we can order do not have an activation fee, so you can use those on your trips too! VISA cards also make great gifts.

Are you considering using Wayfair or Overstock.com for some updates—we sell those! Have you gone to the Marcus Theatre lately? We can get those too. They can be used for tickets as well as your popcorn and beverage! Summer project—Home Depot, Lowe's, ACE, Menards, Fleet Farm—we carry them!

Do you own a business, or do you have an expense account for your job? Would you be able to buy physical gift cards or e-cards to use for work? Think office supplies like those from Office Depot/Max, Target or Wal-Mart. How about gas for your vehicle from BP or Kwik Trip? Do you get equipment from Fleet Farm, Ace Hardware or Menards? How about that order you place periodically from Amazon? We can set you up with SCRIP cards for all those businesses as well as many others.

There is a list of all current gift cards available on the bulletin board by the Scrip table. Check through the list to see if there are some you would like us to order for you. There are many that might surprise you and the rebates average 4-15% for ASLC!

You can also order any gift cards online at [RaiseRight](#). Please register a family account and use the ASLC enrollment code that is posted on the bulletin board behind the table. You will also need this code to set up an account on the RaiseRight app. There are some cards that are only available as e-cards and you would need to get the app to order and use those—like Airbnb or some airlines.

And there are additional bonuses for All Saints that are only available with the app. You can order on the spot and do not have to plan a week ahead. For Example—if your hot water heater goes out, you can use RaiseRight to buy a Home Depot ecard in any amount (\$5 increment), get the ecard on your phone right at Home Depot. Also, for most merchant cards ordered through RaiseRight, cards can be ordered in almost any amount. You can buy a Home Depot card for \$1,450, so you don't have to go through 15 \$100 cards. Your bank transfer costs \$0.29, no matter what the amount of gift card you order! OR—how many different gift cards you add to the one order—still only \$0.29! There are close to 700 different companies which offer cards on the app. If you have any questions or need help with RaiseRight, feel free ask at the table.

NEW--there is a feature on the RaiseRight app called Local Dining. If you attach a credit card or debit card to your app, you can earn additional money for church. Every time you dine and pay with that linked card, you'll automatically earn 5% for ASLC. Currently there are 186 listings in our area, and more are added every day. Ella's Public House and Pacific Bistro are examples of 2 local ones.

We have enjoyed wonderful support from our congregation and ask that you continue to buy Scrip cards in the future. We want to continue making generous and greatly appreciated donations for missions in the future.
