## **Financial Update – July 2026**

***\*Report Accurate as of the end of July 2026, rounded to nearest dollar***

July Income: \$27,601 (Includes monthly amortized annual gifts of \$6,719)

July Expenses: \$21,838

July special gifts and expenses for Mortgage reduction

- (not included in above figures): \$28,000

Cumulative Income through July 2026: \$176,127

- (not including mortgage reduction)

Actual Expenses through July 2026: \$178,536

- (not including mortgage reduction)

Planned Expenses through July 2026: \$174,969

- (not including mortgage reduction)

We have had a great summer financially as a church, with a net positive at the end of the months of June and July. We're still operating with a slight deficit, but the amount has decreased each month for the last 5 months and is currently \$2409. Thank you for your steady and generous giving!

As of today (this includes some August donations), we have sent just over \$33,000 to Thrivent for mortgage principal reduction. Thank you for your incredibly generous response to this second mile giving. These gifts will help ensure our expenses can stay as low as possible for the next ten years – what a great legacy gift!
